Effective as of July 15, 2009, Woodland Medical Center, Woodland Hills Behavioral Health Center and Woodland Medical Center Home Health will be sold to Cullman Regional Medical Center. Cullman Regional Medical Center has decided that it will cease operations of these facilities on that date while it determines the best use of the Woodland campus. Woodland Medical Center, Woodland Hills Behavioral Health Center and Woodland Medical Center Home Health will continue to provide services as normal until July 1, 2009. Beginning on July 1, 2009, these facilities will only provide services to patients who had previously been admitted for treatment for care and who are still inpatients or in a current course of treatment on July 1, 2009. On July 15, 2009, Woodland Medical Center and Woodland Hills Behavioral Health Center will close and all remaining patients will be transferred to other health care providers and all of Woodland Medical Center Home Health's patients requiring additional home health services should contact another home health care provider. In addition, all Medicare Health Care Benefits Agreements relating to these facilities will be terminated on July 15, 2009, and none of these facilities will participate in the Medicare program after that date.
